Media: Original Oil, Acrylic, collage, mixed media, pastel, pen and ink, pencil, photography, sculpture, and watercolor are the accepted mediums. Digitally altered photography will not be accepted.

Art must have been completed within the last two (2) years. Works, which have received an award higher than honorable mention, are not eligible. All work must be original, not a copy of another artist’s work or from a magazine, book or photograph not originally taken by the artist or used without permission from the photographer. Any copies will be removed. Art must not be a giclee, or reproduction. Art must be the sole creation of the artist without physical assistance from another artist or instructor.

Be prepared to show references if asked. Works must be thoroughly dry and suitably framed or gallery wrapped with painted, staple free edges that are not white. They must have a wire in the back for hanging that does not come higher than 3 inches from the top of the painting. Works must not exceed 48X48 inches including frame. Framed works larger than a half sheet of standard watercolor paper (15X22) must be framed using plexi-glass/acrylic, not regular glass. Sculptures should have their own pedestal and not exceed 40 pounds in weight. Paintings sold during the show must remain in the gallery until the end of the show.

Award winners must be present or represented at the opening or forfeit their cash award to the CCAL Scholarship fund. Cash award recipients will be notified by telephone. The number of entries and judging costs will determine prizes. Gallery receiving personnel have the right to reject any unsuitable or objectionable pieces.

Fees: \$20 up to three entries for members, \$30.00 for non-members for three entries. Make checks payable to the Cape Coral Art League. CCAL members are required bring refreshments to the reception and to docent at least one afternoon during the hours the gallery is open.

Commission: 30% of all sales to be made to CCAL by the selling artist. Art sold during the show must remain in the gallery until the official show removal time.

Receiving: Monday, March 1, 2010, 12-3

Removal: April 5, 2010; 2-4 pm. All entries must remain in the gallery until the show is officially closed. Entries must be picked up at the designated time
