

**Bonnie Broitzman's Supply List for Children's Portraits Workshop**  
**March 10 - 12, 2011**

**PAPER:** quarter sheets of ARCHES 140lb cold press. (At least four pieces) A notebook for notes and any sketching I may personally help you with.

**PENCILS:** I like the number two pencils, but I never use their erasers. If you have an entire set of drawing pencils bring them. I especially recommend the HB and 2B pencils, a ruler and a sharpener. Please bring a fine-tipped permanent black marker.

**ERASERS:** A KNEADED ERASER for portrait drawing is a must. I will have extras if you cannot get one before the workshop. I also use the Mars Plastic erasers.

**PAINTS:** Bring your current watercolors and brushes. I like a low water container that has at least two divisions, paper and old terry towels, as well as pop-up tissues. I will be providing any special colors that I want you to experience.

**PHOTO REFERENCES:** I have all the photo references that you need, but if you are working from one of your own, please enlarge your original to five and one-half inches from the top of the head (not hair) to the chin. It is helpful to make a black and white copy for a value study at the same time that you make your color copy into an eight and one-half inch by eleven page, that way they are exactly the same size. Directional light from one source helps us achieve a more three dimensional image and a few cast shadows add interest.

**CAMERA** (optional)
