	 The Art Council of SW FL is celebrating 60 years Anniversary. There will be a celebration April 16 at the Naples Gallery in the Coastland Center Mall. Below are some benefits from membership: Any Member can exhibit at either of the 2 CoCo galleries in Estero or Naples. If anyone is interested there is a website with the information. Our league can hold a member show in the gallery at no additional cost. This is something we might want to consider. There is room for 20 artist to show their work. Each artist gets a panel to display their work. The art council conducts 2 biennial exhibits the Sprint show in even numbered years and the winner circle show in odd numbered years. 3 members have been invited to the show this year. We also have the opportunity to benefit from all sales of work in the gallery from one of our league artists. When a piece sells the artist gets 70% 15% will pay for the rental of space for 10% of gallery expenses and 5% comes back to our league. We can advertise any of our events on their website. Finally the President, Nancy Burk had to resign due to health. The 1st VP has taken over the task, but her term is up in March. There is a need for a president and 1st and 2nd VP.
